Dear Parents and Carers

I have no doubt that with two Bank Holidays and only five weeks in school, this half term will go by in a flash. Please check that they have a reasonable revision timetable that gives them enough breaks, rest and rewards. Please also communicate with us if you have any concerns whatsoever. As per my letter from before the holiday, all Year 11 students will continue to attend their full timetable of lessons outside of their scheduled exams up to the half term break. Further revision sessions will be offered after this time and whilst these are strongly advised, they are not mandatory.

We are very excited to share with you that Heidi, Summer and Phoebe in Year 8 will be representing the UK at an International Cheerleading competition in the USA next week with their club, the Wildcats Athletics.
